# **BETHANY SCHOOL**

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Bethany School is a Catholic minority institution established and run by the Bethany Educational Society, which is registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860. This Educational Society runs more than a hundred formal and non-formal schools all over India.

Bethany School was stated on 8th May 2006 by the Sisters of the Little Flower of Bethany. School is affiliated to CBSE Board, Delhi, Affiliation No. 2430200, School Code: 15552, UDISE Code: 19252002203

## **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

1. The aim of Bethany School, Sulantu is to transform its students into integrated human beings whose intellectual, emotional, moral and physical well-being will enable them to face the challenges of tomorrow, all the while being firmly rooted in one's culture, faith in God and love of neighbour as exemplified in the life and teachings of Lord Jesus Christ.
2. It strives to promote patriotism, spirit of National integration, prides in our culture, heritage and scientific outlook, fellowship, team spirit, service to the community and dignity of manual labour are given importance along with intellectual pursuits.

## **ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL**

3. Admissions are taken for nursery & above.  
\*Information regarding Admission will be put up on the School Notice Board.
4. The School Leaving Certificate will be issued when all dues have been paid in full and on receipt of a written application from the parents/guardian mentioning therein the Admission Number, Class, Section and Roll No. of the pupil.

## **FEES**

5. The school fees cover twelve calendar months and may be paid in four installments or in advance. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods. Pupils are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls. Fees once paid are not refunded.
6. Fees are paid at the school office counter as per the dates given. A fine of Rs. 50/- will be levied on all late payments. Fees for the holiday months are to be paid in advance.
7. Annual fees shall be paid together with Computer fee and Science fee for the new academic session.
8. Parents are requested to keep the receipts issued to them and produce them as a proof of payment, if needed.
9. A fee of Rs. 300/- will be charged whenever application for a Transfer Certificate or for a duplicate of the same is made. A fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged for any extract from the register.
10. Pupils failing to pay the fee for three consecutive months will have their names struck off from rolls. They may be readmitted on clearing all arrears and fines.
11. Pupils joining or leaving the school during any terms will have to pay all the fees for the full term including the annual fee.
12. Pupils whose dues are not cleared completely will be barred from sitting for examinations.
13. The school fees and other charges are liable to be revised from time to time.

## **EVALUATION AND PROMOTION**

14. For the purpose of evaluation, the school conducts regular tests. These tests are taken into account for two terms and promotion exams. Absence from tests will have adverse effect on promotion.
15. There will be continuous evaluation during the year.

16. There is no rank system. All subjects will be marked in Grades or points. It will enable the pupils to work at their own level of ability and compete with oneself.
17. Promotion at the end of the year depends on the all round development of a child, his / her steady progress throughout the year, and his/her ability to cope with a higher class.
18. The final decision regarding promotion rests with the Principal.
19. 85% of attendance is a must for promotion to the next higher class.

### **LEAVE ABSENCE**

20. Leave of absence will be granted only for serious reasons on previous written application from parents or guardians.
21. Prior leave must be obtained for religious ceremonies or special occasions. Reasons such as birthdays, excursions, festivals, social functions, family affairs, urgent business, studying for tests/exams, etc. are not considered sufficient reasons for leave.
22. After being absent from school, the reason for the absence must be written and duly signed by the parents in the "Regularity" record under "Leave".
23. Medical certificate is to be furnished if a child is absent for more than three days on medical grounds.
24. Pupils must not be absent themselves from school on the day prior to holiday or tests/exams. They must rejoin classes after the holidays on the reopening day itself.
25. A pupil who has been absent for 10 calendar days without due authorization from the Principal will be considered as having left the school and his/her name struck off the rolls.
26. Pupil should have minimum of 85% attendance to be eligible for appearing in the Final Examination.

27. Children suffering from contagious or infectious diseases shall not be permitted to attend the school. On recovery they must produce doctor's certificate certifying that he/she has completely recovered and there is no danger of spreading the disease in question.
28. Late arrival to school is a breach of discipline. A student who comes late to school must enter the date and time of arrival in the "Regularity" record under "Late". Students who come late habitually may be sent back home.
29. Readmission to class, for absentees and late comers, is granted only when they show the teacher-in-charge the Regularity Record duly countersigned by the Principal.
30. Any Leave involving more than ten calendar days must be applied for in person and a written permission obtained from the Principal.

### **GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE**

31. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience, disrespect towards the members of the staff, unruly behaviour or conduct injurious to the moral tone of the school are sufficient reasons for dismissal of a student at any time of the year.
32. While utmost precaution is taken, the school cannot be held responsible for accidents minor or serious to pupils during the stay in the school or while taking part in sports or co-curricular activities within or outside the school premises.
33. Guardians / Parents are requested to make proper arrangement to collect their ward immediately after the school hours.
34. The school diary is a record concerning the student. Therefore, bring the school diary daily to school.
35. Any misbehaviour of a serious nature that has become public knowledge is liable to bring about suspension or dismissal, even though it took place out of the school premises.

36. Any damage done to the school property must be made good by the pupils.
37. No magazines, papers or books other than school text books and the School Diary, may be brought to the school without the permission of the Principal. Parcels and letters are subject to inspection.
38. No buying/selling of stamps, stickers, comic books etc. is allowed in the school. Items such as supari, chewing gum, mobile phones, smart watch etc. are strictly forbidden in the school and stern measures will be taken against offenders in this regard.
39. Participation in games, physical training, cultural activities and Socially Useful Productive Works (SUPW), is compulsory. Exemption will be granted on medical grounds only.
40. Pupils are strictly forbidden to form any association or to engage themselves in any group activity or to raise funds for any purpose without the permission of the Principal.
41. English should be spoken in the school premises at all times in order to acquire fluency in speaking the language.
42. For the well being and smooth running of the school, authorities may ask the guardian to withdraw his/her wards from the school without assigning any reason.
43. Students are required to address teachers and all members of the staff, teaching and non-teaching with due respect and politeness. Students must show gentleness and courtesy to their companions, refinement of manners, uprightness and self-restraint should be the distinguishing marks of our pupils.
44. Pupils are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belongings. Each article should be marked with pupil's name.
45. a) Every student should wear a clean and proper uniform daily.  
b) Ornaments and jewellery of any kind are not allowed in the school.  
c) Avoid applying Mehendi, Bangles, Earrings & Nail polish when send them to school.

## **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

46. Excellence in academics alone does not make a complete person. Hence the school organizes a number of co-curricular activities and cultural programmes for the total development of the students. All students are obliged to take part in it.
47. Some of the activities and competitions that are organized in the school are sports and Games, Drama, Debates, Concerts, Calligraphy and Exhibitions.

## **TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS**

48. Parents/Guardians are requested to collect their wards within 15 minutes after the school gets over, after which the school does not take any responsibility.
49. Enrolment in the school implies, on the part of the parents and students, willingness to comply with the requirements and regulations of the school
50. Parents are requested to notify the school authority whenever there is a change in their address or telephone numbers, as recorded in Student's Personal Record.
51. Parents/guardians are not allowed to see their wards or interview teachers, during school hours.
52. The results of the Term Evaluation will be given only to the parents/guardians, and that too only on the specified dates.
53. Parents retain their rights and duties in the education of the children, even though they delegate a part of it to the school. The support and collaboration of parents/guardians in all cases is considered valuable to the success of the work of education carried out by the school.

54. Parents and guardians are requested to co-operate with the school authorities :

- By inculcating in their wards, regular and punctual attendance.
- By seeing that their wards are diligent in doing their home work and other assignments.
- By insisting on neatness and cleanliness in their work and personal appearance.
- By regularly going through the Regularity records and other section of the calendar.
- By promptly countersigning the Report Card, copies and School Diary.
- By occasionally meeting the Principal and the teachers to discuss the progress of their wards. Communication with the parents/guardians is made through the school diary and to sign the remarks/comments made by the Principal/Teachers. All communications should be addressed to the Principal.
- Plan your holidays and tours as per your child's holidays.
- Parents/Guardians are requested to affix their specimen signature/initial in the space indicated in the school diary. No other signatures will be accepted in the Regularity Records, Report Cards, Test papers etc.
- The Principal can be met on all working days from 9.00 am. to 10.30 am.
